2023 JH Performance Boat Owners' Tournament Rules

- 1. All entrants must fish from a JH Performance boat.
- 2. An entry fee of \$300 will be charged per team. \$100 per person over 3 people. Max of 5 people per team. All entry fees are non-refundable. The \$100 entry fee includes tournament entry, dinner Friday, lunch/dinner Saturday after weigh-in, 5 raffle tickets, and goodie bag (hat, t-shirt, koozie, etc).
- 3. Tournament sign up closes 8:00pm Friday October 13, 2023.
- 4. All boats and team members must depart from the Matagorda Harbor the morning of the tournament. No fishing lines or team members out of the boat until 7:00am & after the team has checked in at the Matagorda Harbor.
- 5. All entrants must fish within plain eyesight of their designated JH Performance boat.
- 6. All fish must be caught on rod and reel with strict adherence to federal, state, and local laws, as well as, Texas Parks and Wildlife fishing and boating regulations.
- 7. Live bait, dead bait, and artificial lures may be used.
- 8. All fish being submitted for tournament must be of legal size as per current Texas Parks & Wildlife regulations.
- 9. All fish being weighed must be caught after team leaves from the Matagorda Harbor the morning of October 14, 2023. No culling of dead fish allowed.
- 10. No fish may be accepted from or given to another team.
- 11. Weigh in will be held at the Matagorda Harbor on Saturday October 14, from 12:00pm-3:00pm. Any entrant who is not at the line at the scales before 3:00pm will not be permitted to weigh their fish. ** ONLY 2 PEOPLE PER TEAM ARE ALLOWED TO WEIGH FISH **
- 12. All fish must be brought to the scales in a net or bucket. If you bring your fish to the scales in a cooler full of icy water you will be sent to the back of the line and required to present them in a bucket or net.
- 13. In the event of a boat breakdown, the tournament director must be notified by 3:00pm.
- 14. The weighmaster and tournament director have final decision on validity of fish.
- 15. Fish will be weighed on one scale and will only be weighed once- no re-weighs, no exceptions.
- 16. Once a fish is measured and weighed, there will be no exchanging of fish.
- 17. You are allowed to use a fish more than once the same trout can be part of your stringer and side pot.
- 18. Your stringer does not have to be complete in order to place in the tournament. There is no minimum number of fish required to be legal for overall stringer weight.
- 19. No altered or mutilated fish will be allowed. Fish will be inspected for alterations in size, length, and weight.
- 20. In the event of a tie, the team/individual that weighs in first will win.
- 21. Polygraph tests may be administered to any team member at any time. All entrants must be present to take a polygraph. If any entrant is not available or capable (i.e. intoxicated) to be tested, the entire team may be disqualified.
- 22. Sponsors, organizers, and other entities involved in the tournament are not responsible for any accident, injury, nor loss, damage, or theft to any property.

Categories are as follows:

Team Side Pots - \$100 per each side pot per each team (optional)

Spot Pot - redfish with the most spots

Spots must be bigger than a pencil eraser to count. Validity of spots will be determined by weighmaster/ tournament director.

Blackjack Trout - trout closest to 21"

Fish will be measured closest to 21" and under. Any fish measuring above 21" will be disqualified.

Heaviest Flounder

Ghost Fish – Following weigh in, a species (redfish or trout, flounder excluded) will be pulled randomly. Followed by a random pound, followed by a random ounce.
